President's Message

I'll start by saying, this past year may have been the most challenging one we have faced since I became involved in 2005. At the same time, it has been extremely rewarding, as we are caring for more children than ever before.



The highlights

In addition to our Paso Robles clinic, we now see children one day a week in San Luis Obispo at the Noor Dental Clinic. While the site is not optimum for pediatric care, our staff is dedicated to making the most of this unique opportunity to serve many more children in our county. We are greatly appreciative of their work and professionalism.

As of July, Dr. Andi Livingood was promoted to Dental Director, taking over for Dr. Jimmy Forester who is splitting his time between Tolosa Children's Dental Center and his new private practice. Dr. Livingood shares our passion for serving the dental needs of underserved children, and brings great clinical skills, compassion, and a willingness to mentor those with whom she works.

Our two main fundraising events of the year---Continuing Education Course and Sunset Barbecue---were our most successful-to-date! BIG THANKS to Drs. Paul Vanderheyden, Patrick Goroski, Jeff Hollister and Lynn Sayre-Carstairs for being our Continuing Education Course guest lecturers, contributing their time and sharing their expertise in periodontics with over 80 local dental professionals in early June. Also, BIG THANKS to Meathead Movers and Coastal Pediatric Dentistry for their support as corporate sponsors of the Sunset Barbecue dinner/auction/dance at the San Luis Obispo Country Club. We would not have been as successful without the generous support of these individuals.

The challenges

Even before the State of California cut Medi-Cal reimbursement rates by ten percent in late 2013, California already had one of the lowest rates of Medicaid reimbursement in the entire country. Over the last year the rate cut acutely affected our dental operations to the point of raising concern about how long we could remain open.

At the same time, with the initiation of the Affordable Care Act, more children than ever have become eligible for Medi-Cal. As a result, the increase in demand for our services has been so great that we cannot meet the demand in a timely manner. That means a child may have to wait as long as 4-5 months for an appointment in order to receive necessary treatment. In pediatric dentistry, this is less than ideal.

What we're doing

Taking the offensive to address these challenges, we contracted with the California Dental Association Practice Advisory Service early this year to consult and advise. The board has since met often with key staff to develop strategies identified to help keep us sustainable. Our primary efforts are focused on improving operational efficiencies; increasing revenue via new payer sources; researching new grant opportunities; and building much greater donor support.

The bottom line

Though the state legislature reversed the ten percent cut in their June budget revision, we have yet to see the money. In reality, it is still

Present Challenges, Future Dreams

In May of this year, I celebrated my eighth anniversary as the Clinic Director at Tolosa Children's Dental Center. It has been an amazing adventure of challenges and accomplishments. We



provided care to over 5,000 children this past year---almost 1,000 more than the previous year. If you multiply 5,000 by two or three appointments for each child, you can quickly discover how busy we are.

Given that our State reimbursement is less than forty cents for every dollar of care we provide, maintaining quality for that number of children is a very big accomplishment. Unfortunately, the large number of children seen this past year was still not enough to meet the increasing needs within our County. With both of our offices at capacity, for the first time in our history, we have had to stop taking new patients. This decision saddens us all. However, to ensure that we can provide timely care to the patients we currently have, we had no choice at this time. Once we have determined a solution that allows for more children to be seen and cared for in a timely manner, we will begin accepting new patients again.

While there are reports of some improvement in the oral health of the children in SLO County, our numbers are still showing that at least 60% of the children we see have active decay. And, there are many more out there that have not had a complete exam and x-rays in a dental office. So, at TCDC, we continue to determine how/if we can increase capacity.

Each year I have shared some item of growth/expansion that we accomplished at TCDC. No longer seeing any way to expand within the walls of our current facilities, I now dream of a large sum of money appearing in the bank account---a sum large enough to fund a bigger facility both in Paso Robles and San Luis Obispo! Call me crazy, but one thing working at TCDC has taught me is to believe in what needs to happen. Believe...so that we can continue and increase the services we provide.

SO, until my dream becomes a reality, the amazing staff and I will continue on here at TCDC, focusing on each child we see, providing a positive dental experience, educating families and delivering quality dentistry. This is what we do, and I am very proud to be a part of it.



An Overview of Periodontal Issues in the Dental Practice

A volunteer panel of four prominent local dentists addressed a packed auditorium of fellow dental professionals at the June 5th class. Patrick Goroski DDS, spoke about the diagnosis and management of peri-implant disease; Jeff Hollister DDS MS, addressed immediate implant placement vs. extraction, and ridge preservation; Lynn Sayre-Carstairs DMD, covered dental lasers in periodontics and the pinhole surgical technique; and Paul Vanderheyden DDS, spoke on the topic of soft tissue grafting techniques for challenging situations.
